## **AIHFS AWARDED NEW CAMPUS GRANT FROM THE PRIORITY HEALTH TOTAL HEALTH FOUNDATION**

**[Detroit, Michigan]** - American Indian Health & Family Services (AIHFS) is proud to announce the receipt of a \$100,000 grant from the Priority Health Total Health Foundation to support a new 29,000 square foot health and wellness campus situated on 5.3 acres in Detroit. The construction of the state-of-the-art facility is currently underway, with more than 50% of the project completed, and it is projected to be finalized in October 2026. These funds will specifically be allocated towards construction costs and a naming opportunity for designated rooms. This essential project will not only enhance existing services but also facilitate the expansion of new services to the community. This meaningful investment will strengthen AIHFS's organizational infrastructure and support long-term sustainability as the organization continues to expand access to culturally grounded health and wellness services.
